ADAPTIVE RECREATION

The Adaptive Recreation program was founded in 1975 and since then has evolved into a year-round program offering a variety of recreational activities for individuals with intellectual disabilities divided in the following age categories:

*Youth = 3-12 years *Teens = 13-17 years *Adults = 18 years and older

The Adaptive Recreation's mission is to provide accessible traditional, innovative, and affordable quality activities and programs for Rochester's residents with intellectual and physical challenges through year-round activities specifically adapted to meet a variety of intellectual functioning levels.

Our program serves approximately 2,000 people annually with special needs; we also provide inclusive opportunities for families as well.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

When can I register? Beginning: 8:00 a.m. Monday, Nov. 7 Until: 5:00 p.m. Friday, Nov. 18

Spaces are on a first-come, first-serve basis; classes may fill before the end of the registration period.

Can I submit registration before the opening date? No, unfortunately we cannot accept registration via any method prior to Monday, November 7th, nor can we reserve spaces.

Participant Policies

In order to provide a safe and healthy environment for all and by participating in our program you are agreeing to adhere to the following guidelines . . .

Safe and appropriate social behavior

Participants will refrain from any behavior that is disruptive or detrimental to the group (i.e. hitting, kicking, self-abuse, shouting, refusal to stay with the group, etc.). Staff are hired and trained to deal with a variety of issues that when working in the arena of children with special needs are common, however they are not expected to deal with significant behaviors or medical issues. Each occurrence will be assessed on a 'case by case basis' to assess whether it rises to a level that compromises the safety and well-being of other participants as well as the staff. Participants displaying unsafe behaviors will be required to provide staffing or to withdraw from the activity with the balance of the fee refunded.

Behavioral/Medical Issues

Arrangements must be made for participants with significant behavior and/or medical issues to provide assistance when attending activities.

Late Pick Up

Please be on time for programs and pickups. When participants are not picked up on time it costs the program in terms of staff time. These costs will result in a \$10 assessed late fee once the program time has passed. The fee increases by 15 minute increments until the participant is picked up. The balance of the fee must be paid before a participant may resume participation in activities. Three late pickups will result in the termination of participation for the remainder of the session.

Drop Off

Drop off is allowed 15 minutes prior to the activity and no sooner. Consequently, coming late to a program is disruptive; please be timely when attending an activity and if it has already started, come in quietly and take a seat.

Electronic Devices

During an activity, participants, family members, and support staff are asked to keep their cell phones on silent and to put them and all other electronic devices away during activities. Exceptions will be made for devices used to assist with speech.

Food

Participants are asked to refrain from bringing food or snacks to programs unless there is a medical need to do so or unless it is requested for the activity.

Refunds

For a full credit or refund, cancellations must be made 24 hours prior to an activity. Less than 24 hour notice will result in prorated or in no credit or refund depending on the activity. 
