

2019 Public Works Construction Project Summary



Reconstruction of 6th Avenue NW and 7th Avenue NW (J7319)

Construction is anticipated to start in June 2019 and be completed in November 2020.

The project is a complete street reconstruction that includes replacements of water mains, storm sewers, and sanitary sewers. The streets in the project area will be resurfaced and defective sidewalk panels replaced.

Project Benefits

This project will:

- Replace deteriorated pavements
- Replace defective sidewalks
- Alleviate localized street flooding from stormwater
- Create additional sanitary sewer capacity for downtown Rochester

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicle traffic:

- Construction will occur from north to south along the project corridor. Travel lanes will be impacted depending on their proximity to the active construction area.
- Anticipated travel impacts in 2019 are along 6th Avenue NW, 4th Street NW, and possibly 3rd Street NW and 8th Avenue NW.

Impacts to pedestrians:

- Sidewalks within active construction zones will be closed.

Project Cost and Funding

Estimated construction costs are \$5.9M and being funded by general tax levy, State Aid, water utilities and special assessments.
