Public Works is writing to communicate our expectations regarding permit requests and inspections under City Ordinance Sections 12-2 and 9-18.

Please send all **permit requests** to <u>PWpermits@rochestermn.gov</u> or call 507-328-2406. Please do not send permit request via fax. Other permit request reminders:

- Permits must be in the system to receive an inspection.
- Please request permits <u>before</u> work is started to afford us time to identify issues that may delay the start of work.
- Commercial sites require an electronic plan submittal for permit review.

Please schedule **permit inspections** through the main Public Works desk at 507-328-2400. Please note the following:

- Inspections will be scheduled starting at 8:00 AM. The last available inspection will be 3:00 PM each day. NOTE: Emergency inspection requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and may be scheduled outside of standard hours of service.
- Feel free to contact our inspectors for general permit information or to discuss past inspections, but *please do not contact inspectors directly to schedule an inspection*. If you contact inspectors directly for scheduling, they have been instructed to direct you to dispatch at the main Public Works desk at 507-328-2400.

Both City-Owner infrastructure and permitted construction work must be inspected by City staff or their designee and must follow City specifications. Public Works staff members have differing primary assignments; however, they are trained and authorized to represent Public Works for either City-Owner or Permit inspections. As many of you know, City-Owner infrastructure is inspected using a separate process from permitted construction. Please use the following guidelines for routing your requests:

#### **Permit Items**

- Sewer and water service from main to the building
- Private sewer and storm sewer mains
- Public street and sidewalk removal/replacement
- Streetscapes within DMC area may fall under City Owner Contract (case by case)
- All sidewalk and driveway aprons on the public right of way
- All landscaping on public right of way requires Park Department approval
- Obstruction permits when a roadway/sidewalk will be closed to complete permit work
- Other less common improvements

### **City-Owner Contract Items**

- Public water main to and including all fire hydrants
- Hydrant laterals in the right-of-way can be by permit (case by case)
- Water Lines over 100 feet require MDH approval
- Public sanitary and storm sewer including all manholes set on existing mains
- Public street construction
- Downtown sidewalk and accessories (Note DMC areas)
- Sidewalk along out lots
- Mid-block pedestrian connections
- Public storm water ponds and modifications to public storm water ponds
- Various traffic control features
- Other less common improvements
