Applicant proceeds with Project

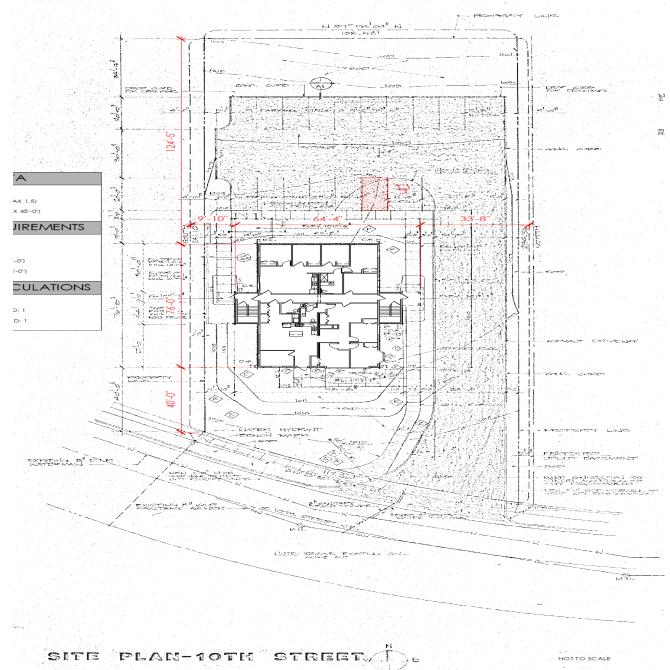
Site Plan
