

If application meets all requirements, application is approved




Full Application Review by City, County, & State departments within 14 days of receiving application






# Site Rendering





## Landscape Plan


- Landscape Requirements (152-ft of frontage):

  - Parking Lot 3 canopy trees, 1 understory, 12 shrubs
  - Zoning District Plantings 1 canopy tree, 15 shrubs
