

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PART OF SILVER LAKE PARK LOCATED NORTH OF SEVENTH STREET NE AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK SITE, REMOVING SILVER LAKE PARK FROM THE HISTORIC INVENTORY LIST, AND AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AS REFERENCED IN 60.200.020(A) OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. The City of Rochester Heritage Preservation Commission held a public hearing and made a recommendation that the Common Council designate the following property as a locally designated historic landmark site. The property subject to historic landmark designation is described as follows and illustrated in Exhibit "A":

Name: Silver Lake Park
Address: North of Seventh Street NE
Rochester, MN 55906

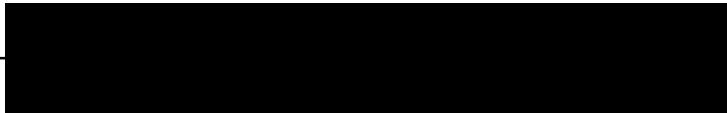
Section 2. On June 26, 2023, the Common Council considered the reports and recommendations of the subject property.

Section 3. On June 26, 2023, the Common Council of the City of Rochester determined that the a part of the Silver Lake Park located north of Seventh Street NE meets the requirements to designate this area as a local historic landmark site for the City of Rochester.

Section 4. Therefore, pursuant to section 60.200.040(C) of the Unified Development Code of the City of Rochester, part of the Silver Lake Park located north of Seventh Street NE shall be designated as a local historic landmark site as illustrated in Exhibit "A" and shall be included to the official list of Landmark Properties.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective from and after publication.
