ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SOLDIERS FIELD MEMORIAL PARK A HISTORIC LANDMARK SITE, REMOVING SOLDIERS FIELD MEMORIAL PARK FROM THE HISTORIC INVENTORY LIST, AND AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AS REFERENCED IN 60.200.020(A) OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. The City of Rochester Heritage Preservation Commission held a public hearing and made a recommendation for the Common Council to designate the following property as a locally designated historic landmark site. The property subject to historic landmark designation is described as illustrated in Exhibit "A":

Section 4. Therefore, pursuant to section 60.200.040(C) of the Unified Development Code of the City of Rochester, the Soldiers Field Memorial Park shall be designated as a local historic landmark site as illustrated in Exhibit "A" and shall be included to the official list of Landmark Properties.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective from and after publication.
